

**Kairos of Georgia Executive Committee
Teleconference Minutes
February 6th, 2018**

POSSIBLE PSA FOR KAIROS TORCH BY JIMMY CARTER: Due to ongoing efforts by Octavia Everett to get Kairos Torch established at Sumter YDC, Mrs. Jimmy Carter has become aware of the ministry and wants their church to become more involved. A recruiting and formation dinner is to be held at that church on February 24th. Doug wants to ask former President Carter and possibly Mrs. Carter to prepare a Public Service Announcement (PSA) to promote Kairos Torch. He does not think a lot of money needs to be spent as the church has audio/video equipment and personnel in place. Motion made, seconded and passed that we (Doug) pursue getting the PSA of former President Carter and possibly Mrs. Carter prepared provided costs are less than \$200.00 and that Kairos retains the rights to use the recording as Kairos sees fit.
