

**Kairos of Georgia Executive Committee Minutes**

Chairman Doug Unger began the meeting at 7:10 PM. Present were Doug Unger, Walter Straham, Stan Yarbrough, Beth Maycomber, Beverly Upperman, Arthur Finkling, Colleen Freemon, Diane Morgan and Tom Kibler. A quorum was determined, and the meeting was opened with prayer by Stan.

**SECRETARY'S REPORT:** Tom provided copies of leader nomination requests. Discussion was made on each request, with some requests being submitted very late for normal preparation for a weekend. **OLD BUSSINESS:** Colleen Freemon reported that five regional AC training events have been held and numerous volunteers have been trained.

**NEW BUSINESS:** Walter went over the 2020 nomination list. Doug Unger will roll off as KOG chair and Beverly Upperman will be submitted as the 2020 nomination for chair. Doug requested and received the National approval for Walter to remain as the Financial Secretary for 2020, with the understanding that a replacement will be found and trained during 2020.
