

**Kairos of Georgia State Chapter Meeting Minutes**  
**June 30th, 2018**  
**Christ United Methodist Church, Forsyth, GA**

Chairman Doug Unger called the meeting to order at 9:00 AM. Stan Yarbrough opened the meeting with prayer, Beverly Upperman gave the devotional and Mike Zoellick led the singing. Roll was taken and a quorum was established. Minutes were previously approved electronically.

**FINANCIAL SECRETARY'S REPORT:** Financial Secretary Walter Straham distributed financial report copies (q.v.) of the Balance Sheet and Profit & Loss YTD (May 31<sup>st</sup>). Walter reminded us how to properly document Gifts-In-Kind (GIK). These are supplies, meals and such given in lieu of money. The value of GIK needs to be reported as a donation and the donor needs to receive a letter of contribution at year's end. Walter also discussed the Financial Policy (q.v.) and "inter-ministry blessing".

**TREASURERS REPORT:** Treasurer Stan Yarbrough reminded the group that he has pre-printed deposit slips that the AC treasurers should use to make deposits. If a deposit is mailed to SunTrust the date of the deposit in DONOR should coincide with date on the deposit receipt from SunTrust.

**AKT REPORT:** Lillian Robinson reported that future AKT dates are: August 17<sup>th</sup>-19<sup>th</sup>, 2018, February 15<sup>th</sup>-17<sup>th</sup>, 2019 and August 9<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup>, 2019. These are scheduled at the Fortson 4H Center, 999 Fortson Rd, Hampton, GA 30228. Lillian asked for volunteers to help with the logistics (attendee travel from the airport, food pick-up, etc.)

**CHAIRMAN'S REPORT:** Doug reported that the Re-entry Summit was a great opportunity for establishing rapport with a number of state DOC personnel and a great time to disseminate info about the Kairos Ministry. The PSA by former President Jimmy Carter has been completed and is in the process of being edited for time and content and should be available for use shortly.

**EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING REPORT:** Beverly Upperman reported on this. Of note are two (2) motions that passed during the meeting. One motion gives authority to the Ex. Comm. to establish a policy to identify non-compliant (out of the riverbanks) Advisory Councils and enumerates the consequences those ACs can expect. **The second passed motion was that there be a mandatory meeting August 18<sup>th</sup>, 2018 requiring the attendance of at least one of the following AC officers: AC Chair, AC Vice-chair and AC Secretary. This is to be a state-wide meeting. Tentative time is from 10:00 AM till 2:00 PM and tentative place is Christ UMC in Forsyth. Beverly Upperman is coordinating this.** The Ex. Comm. minutes will be available on the Kairos of Georgia website once the approval process is completed later this month.

**STATUS OF NEW STARTS:** Atlanta YDC is having their first Weekend September 21<sup>st</sup>-23<sup>rd</sup>, 2018. Sumter YDC is in the planning stages.

**RECRUITMENT ACTIVITIES:** Doug reminded everyone that Kairos of Georgia will pay for reasonable recruiting expenses (dinners). Contact Doug about this.

**WEEKEND LEADER APPROVAL:** Due to some of the applications needing vetting, this item was tabled to an Ex. Comm. Teleconference.
