

STATE REQUIREMENTS FOR KAIROS WEEKEND LEADER

The Weekend Leader is selected by the Advisory Council, nominated to and must be approved by the State Committee Chairman.

The Leader must have been prepared for leadership by a growing experience of job responsibilities that broaden his or her understanding of the ministry as set forth in the Kairos Program Manual through the local Advisory Council. This training is intended to show the leader how to humbly, but confidently build a team and then to motivate, inspire and prepare that team into a Spiritual body that works in confidence because of those preparations with the help of the Holy Spirit.

The following requirements apply for State approval of the nominee:

- 1) All Kairos Leaders must attend Advanced Kairos Training at least six months before the weekend; however it is recommend 12-18 months before.
- 2) Understand and accept any specific requirements of the local ministry as directed by the local Advisory Council.
- 3) Must have read, understand, and display a willing Spirit regarding the team formation process, as set forth in the Kairos Program Manual, Section III.
- 4) Must have demonstrated a willingness to comply with the policies and guidelines set forth in the Program Manual, Ezra Team Formation software, Planning Guide for Leaders Guide and the State Committee.
- 5) Must be willing to sacrifice those Christian practices not held in common and are not universally practiced by all dominations while

conducting team training and during the weekend. The following practices are specifically not permitted:

- ❖ Alter calls
- ❖ Speaking in tongues
- ❖ Baptism
- ❖ Communion
- ❖ Healing services
- ❖ Praying the Rosary
- ❖ Slaying in the Spirit
- ❖ Stations of the cross, and
- ❖ Anointing with oil
- ❖ Serenades

6) Must have been interviewed by the Local Advisory Council and the above requirements reviewed and addressed on the Weekend Leader nomination form.
