1. Call to order – Beverly

4. Secretary Report – Diane
 - A. Presented Variances and Jot Forms:

 - Nominations approved – Valdosta: Taylor Elliott, Malcolm Wright, Russell Silva; Augusta Medical: Chuck Lee (previously approved 8/2024), Dale Wilmer
 - Nominations Delayed: Kairos Outside of Ga: Tammy Calhoun will be reviewed in August. (Confusion about dates. Her AKT date is beyond 2 years). Valdosta: Luther Joiner’s Talks need verification.
 - B. NOTE: Variance Request and Leader Nominations Forms MUST be received three days prior to the State Executive Committee Meeting the Friday before the State Chapter Committee Meeting to give enough time for form(s) to be reviewed.
5. Financial Reports – Roxann presented Balance Sheet, Profit and Loss. We are in good shape financially

6. Treasurer – David: Received call from Valdosta regarding storage unit. Store there or move to Forsyth? Suggested they inventory contents and determine what they will use, need to toss or donate. Roxann said someone in Coffee County is getting calls about KI after Beverly & Walter’s visit there. She only wants KO calls. Beverly will follow up.
7. IC Report – Dawson & Vanessa: AC Chairs need to know who their EI input person is. A presentation on EI is available. Evelyn asked that Annual Conference registrants need to attend workshops. Asked that we stress the Walk-a-thon this month, sign up for prayer vigil slots and pray for first Men’s Weekend in Africa.

9. Chair Report

- DOC Updates
 - A. Photos inside the prison: DOC says no photos should be taken. Chaplain Ellis stated that some family members of victims don't want photos taken of the perpetrator. IF Prison Chaplain and Warden OK photo to be taken, AC needs to get that agreement in writing.
 - B. If the deceased person's family asks for donations to be made to Kairos in the obituary, ensure that funds be sent directly to the Kairos Mailbox, rather than an individual. Kairos of Georgia State Treasurer, PO Box 5743 Forsyth, GA 31029 and to designate which facility the donation should go.
 - C. From Evelyn:
 - Use non-alcohol hand sanitizer or closely monitor its use. Inmate used sanitizer containing alcohol in his coffee to get a high.
 - Some volunteers serve in both KI and KO. This could be a conflict of interest as there may be a temptation to carry messages from inmates to family or friend. More conversation is needed.
