I know it's hard for you with me being in prison. I have recently met some people who genuinely care about our struggles. Many of them also have relatives/friends in prison. They are building Christian communities both inside and outside the prison.

The community is called Kairos (it means God's Special Time), and I recently went to one of their retreats held here. They also have retreats, twice each year, for female relatives/friends called Kairos Outside.

Women, some of whom also have incarcerated relatives/friends, lead the retreats (also called Weekends). The Weekend is held Friday night through Sunday afternoon at _____ and there is no charge to attend. If needed they can help provide transportation for you to and from the Weekend, and, if needed, they may be able to help pay for a babysitter (they can't recommend a sitter).

I have filled out a Guest Reservation Form agreeing to support you emotionally and with prayers and have given it to them. Someone will be calling you with details about their upcoming Weekend. In the meantime, here is one of their brochures.

After you attend a Weekend, I believe our relationship will grow. You will meet women who understand your struggles. They won't expect anything of you.
