

Kairos of Georgia State Chapter Meeting Minutes
January 20th, 2017
Christ United Methodist Church, Forsyth, GA

Chairman Doug Unger called the meeting to order at 9:05 AM. Jim Smith gave the devotional and the opening prayer. Roll was taken and a quorum was established. Minutes were previously approved electronically.

ASSISTANT DOC COMMISSIONER JAY SANDERS: Jay stated that each month 3000 to 3500 volunteers come into the institutions around the state. DOC wants to make it easier for volunteers to obtain their badges. The goal is to put the entire volunteer “package” on the website with a training video whether faith-based or other volunteer organizations (GED, finance, etc.). Renewal is going to a five-year period but with annual background check and PREA. FINANCIAL SECRETARY’S REPORT: Financial Secretary Walter Straham distributed financial report copies (q.v.) of the Balance Sheet and Profit & Loss YTD Comparison through December 31st 2017. 13 ACs had a negative income for 2017 but overall the ministry is in good financial condition.

TREASURERS REPORT: Treasurer Stan Yarbrough reminded the group that he has pre-printed deposit slips that the AC treasurers should use to make deposits. The AC treasurers should contact Stan when they need more slips.

AKT REPORT: Beth Maycomber reported for Lillian that the next AKT training will be held February 16th-18th, 2018 at the Fortson 4H Center, 999 Fortson Rd, Hampton, GA 30228.

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING REPORT: Beverly Upperman reported on this. The minutes will be available on the Kairos of Georgia website once the approval process is completed later in February.

CHAIRMAN’S REPORT: Doug reported again that there continues to be Weekends held that do not have enough volunteers to support the number of tables set up. This is not within the Riverbanks. Weekend Leaders are still not completing their reports in a timely manner. David Griffin stated that the prior participant list is complete as far as the information he has at present. He reiterated that Weekend Leaders need to put the DOC # of each participant in the Leader’s Report. This is the only way to accurately track an individual, especially when some have the same names. He has received several that did not include the DOC numbers and couldn’t use them. At present the Men’s KI list has about 18,000 names on 710 pages.

NEW BUSINESS: Motion made, seconded and passed to approve Christopher West as the Weekend Leader for Atlanta YDC Torch #1. Motion made, seconded and passed to change the March 31st meeting date to March 17th. March 31st is the day before Easter. Also, Evelyn Lemly KPMI Executive will be able to join us on the 17th. In addition to March 17th, future SCC meeting dates are June 30th, September 29th and December 1st. At present all meetings will be held at Christ United Methodist Church in Forsyth, GA.

There being no further business before the committee, benediction was delivered and the meeting adjourned at 12:30 PM.
