Virtual GoTo Meeting Minutes
January 28, 2022

Chair Beverly Upperman began the meeting at 7:00 PM. Participating were Beverly Upperman, Tom Kibler, Walter Larry and David Griffin. A quorum was determined to be present.

Beverly led us in a devotional from Matthew 14: 25-29. Do we recognize Jesus in the storm? Only Peter called out to Jesus. Anytime Jesus invites us to do something, He will equip us.

Beverly nominated Ron Jones for the 2022 State Clergy Recruiting/Training position. Ron was approved unanimously.

Beverly led us with a prayer.

SECRETARY'S REPORT: The only active ACs not getting the 2022 AC Elections into Kairos Messenger are Valdosta SP and Macon YDC. Also not entered in Messenger is Autry, Dooly and Ware which are listed as in-active at this time.

FINANCIAL REPORT: Walter reviewed the current Balance Sheet and P & L report. Very little expenses occurred in 2021 and the donations from churches and organizations continued to come in. Over \$88K was raised in 2021, with \$31,802 income after all expenses. Walter reported that our investment account is \$197,747.90 and our total assets are better than \$400k. Walter and committee discussed using the PEX cards for upcoming weekends and how to monitor the issuance and use of the card.

TREASURERS REPORT: The new address for the Kairos of Georgia mailbox is Kairos of Georgia State Treasurer, P.O. Box 5743, Forsyth, GA 31029. David asked if the State Financial Secretary or Treasurer had any ability to follow up on whether AC 2021 donor tax letters should be sent out by 1/31/22. Walter will remind the AC Chairs that they need to follow up with their AC Financial Secretary to ensure that the letters are postmarked by 1/31/22.

IC REPORT: Welcomed Dawson Long as the newly elected, second Georgia Kairos International Council Representative. No report.

CHAIR REPORT:

Discussed expired DOC volunteer badges and need for those impacted in this area to take the necessary actions.

Georgia State Prison is closing later in 2022 (April) and this may be an opportunity for their volunteers to plug in to other local prisons, i.e., Rogers and Smith.

Beverly reviewed and discussed the draft Kairos of Georgia 2022 Annual Plan.

Discussed Macon YDC Torch weekend #1. Looking at two dates in April, but not sure if Georgia can get enough volunteers for the team and the required post weekend mentoring.

Beverly led committee in discussing Autry, Dooly and Ware having trouble getting their AC positions filled for 2022 and having enough volunteers to stay active. Talked about ways the help these ACs and possibly sharing volunteers in 2022, depending on whether surrounding prisons are not having 2022 weekends at this time.

Beverly discussed the 2022 Kairos Annual Conference scheduled for July 26-30, 2022, in Dallas, TX. and who of the Executive Committee might want to attend. After some discussion the entire seven members of the committee were voted to attend the Annual Conference and the recommendation will be
